Minutes of Tivetshall Parish Council Meeting: 7:30 p.m. Tuesday 10th March, 2015, Tivetshall Village Hall

1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.

2. TO RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.

3. TO CONSIDER APPLICANTS FOR CO-OPTION.

4. CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES.

The minutes of the meeting, 10th February, 2015, were presented, approved and signed. There were no matters arising.

5. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION.

- 5.1 Neither Bev Spratt (County Councillor) nor Martin Wilby (District Councillor) were present. Isabelle Agrir (PCSO) reported village crime down, person apprehended, but a reminder to be vigilant; aware of suspicious behaviour/youngsters in cars locally; also reported on recent credit card theft/s in Diss.
- 5.2 Parishioners Forum.
 - 5.2.1 A member of public wished to speak directly with District Councillor.
 - 5.2.2 A member of public gave an update with regard to provision of broadband facilities within the village. Contrary to previous information, the superfast fibre optic broadband not currently available/effective in Tivetshall; a second phase roll-out presently under discussion as to possible location/s.

 Recommended that residents continue to register their own individual concerns/complaints but, agreed that Lynn Jollans will contact Karen O'Kane, Programme Director of the Better Broadband for Norfolk initiative, (karen.okane@norfolk.gov.uk) requesting that she attend a village meeting, to be publicised in Grapevine.
 - 5.2.3 Dog fouling also discussed; Lynn Jollans to contact SNC Dog Warden for advice; make enquiries about stickers; provide more posters; reinforce message via Grapevine.

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6. PLANNING.

6.1 Chestnut Farm, Station Road: grain storage building. No paperwork received; no details available; councillors unable to comment. Lynn Jollans to query consultation.

7. TO RECEIVE REPORTS FROM COUNCILLORS AND DISCUSS CURRENT ISSUES INCLUDING:

- 7.1 Front of Hastoe Housing, Green Lane: after further discussions, following complaint, it was agreed that staggered holly trees remain the preferred option; it was unanimously agreed to authorise purchase; proposed by Lynn Jollans and seconded by Rita Land.
- 7.2 Dog Bin: unanimously agreed to purchase whole package i.e. bin, including delivery, fitting, etc. for £198 from SNC; further £65 for annual emptying/collection charge; proposed by Tony Jollans; seconded by Lynn Jollans.
- 7.3 Signage to church: Lynn Jollans has followed up, plus querying speed restrictions; Tony Jollans to follow up the Rectory Road sign.
- 7.4 Village Hall Extension Project: a meeting with village hall committee needs to be arranged to discuss this further.
- 7.5 Light at A140 bus stop: still being further investigated.
- General maintenance: meeting with resident Thursday to quote for tidying up round bottle bank, and also cutting back long hedge.
 E-mail from resident advising that village green and church benches need attention; agreed to ask Tim Playford to quote to for general maintenance to these along with village notice boards; proposed by Lynn Jollans, and seconded by Tony Jollans.
- 7.7 Defibrillator: good response to initial query forms; local people willing to train and to fund-raise; Tivetshall Allotment Trust offered contribution; enough support to progress project further; Lynn Jollans will get back to ambulance service and British Heart Foundation as to what to do next.
- 7.8 Broadband: as discussed 5.2.2.
- 7.9 Election Paperwork: handed out to Tony Jollans, Rita Land and Christopher Miller; publication 23rd March; nominations should be in by 9th April. Lynn Jollans made it clear she would not be standing.
